# 3 Committee's Message

Dear Bridge friends and members of SCBA,

One phrase that rang heavily in me lately is “either we survive together, or we die one by one.” What does “we” refer to?

- “We” as the Bridge community in Singapore

Despite our respectable performances in international events, they have not translated into a stronger awareness of our sport at the grassroots level. We have a numbers problem. Firstly, there are too few schools with Bridge clubs and many students, including my former self, start learning at 17 years old – which is considered late. Secondly, despite the many benefits that Bridge can bring to the Active Ageing community, such potential is still unrealised in Singapore unlike in the West. Hence, where there is an opportunity to teach Bridge, we need to grab it with both hands. We need to get started, and this begins with all of us. The Canvas for Pilot Interest [form](#) is still up, and I implore all of you to consider putting your name in as a form of giving back to the community what you have received.

- “We” as the Asian nations with Bridge-playing communities

We are still trying very hard to do whatever we can to secure Bridge as a feature in various multi-sport events in the SEA Games and the Asian Games. One of the common themes that keeps resonating is the number of countries with teams competent enough to compete in these games, which needs to meet a hard threshold. Such is also interlinked with the host nation’s will to feature the sport at the games. It may appear political, but to me, this is a result of a chain reaction from having a low awareness of the sport in the region. It doesn’t matter how strong Singapore can perform at the SEA Games if for example, the regional community cannot fulfill the minimum quota of participating nations.

We cannot be content with Bridge being featured in select editions only where the host nation wants it. In fact, in Singapore, it is [even more difficult](#) for us to do so now. If we want Bridge to be a regular feature in the SEA Games, then everyone needs to help each other. Drawing from the article, can we follow Netball’s example to work with other countries to promote the competency of their local places, for everyone’s benefit?

- “We” as the association of mindsport NSAs (National Sports Associations)

Some of us are also aware of the issue on our lease once the current one runs out. While we cannot control what happens after the expiry, we can however act if the outcome is unfavourable for us. All the mindsport NSAs are also very much interested in this topic, and we can secure a much better result only if we negotiate together.

The other point relates to how we represent ourselves externally. Events and outreach efforts can be amplified multi-fold if we collaborate. This way, we can help to utilize economies of scale, increase awareness of mindsports as a lifestyle, and increase the total number of mindsports players in the country. I believe this is the reason why the IMSA (International Mind Sports Association) was formed at the international level, and while we are just a small stakeholder in international affairs, we could extend the same thinking domestically. Moving forward, the committee will be exploring these partnerships, but we hope that you can offer your hands when they involve public outreach activities.

In short, the larger we are, the more leverage we have in every situation.

At the local level, we have released the flyers and online entry forms for Easter Congress and the brand-new National School Bridge League, along with their Supplementary Conditions of Contests. We hope that the innovations for these events can integrate more members of our Bridge-playing community via a renewed purpose to participate. We have also opened participation for the H S Ho Challenge and Hong Bao pairs, of which the latter has a buffet dinner. Please support these events and broadcast them to your friends (especially overseas friends for Easter Congress), and we look forward to your enthusiastic participation.

There are many challenges for the Association moving forward, but we can also be nimble as we are small. Let's all work together towards this purpose of making Bridge a respected sport within Singapore.

## Donations to SCBA

**Enjoy a 250% deduction on taxable income by donating to SCBA.  
Qualification for tax deduction is valid until further notice.**

### Types of Tax Deductible Donations Available

1. Unrestricted donation to one of our three funds: General Fund, Bridge Development Fund, National Bridge League Fund
2. Restricted donation to set up a new fund for purposes dictated by the donor (SCBA will inform and seek the donor's opinion if the fund cannot be used)
3. Donations to name SCBA's events or programmes;
4. Donations where SCBA or its approved beneficiary acknowledges the donation by including the donor's name or logo in the SCBA's collaterals (e.g. banners, publications, advertisements). Examples would be Pesta Sukan Bridge Championships and future iterations of SEABCC and APBF if they are held in Singapore.

### Claiming Tax Deductible Donations

Tax deduction is given for donations made in the preceding year. For example, if an individual makes a donation in 2023, tax deduction will be allowed in his tax assessment for the Year of Assessment (YA) 2024. The tax deductions for qualifying donations will be automatically reflected in the donor's tax assessments based on the information from the IPC (such as the donor's name, date and amount of donation on the tax deduction receipt).

Ho Weng Toh (Captain Ho)  
(1920 – 2024)

Captain Ho is well-known for being one of the last surviving members of the Flying Tigers, during which he flew 18 missions and operated a B25 Mitchell Bomber during World War II.

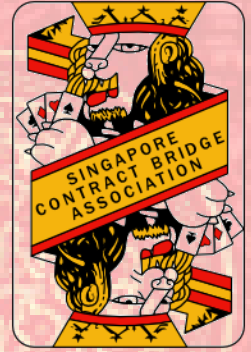

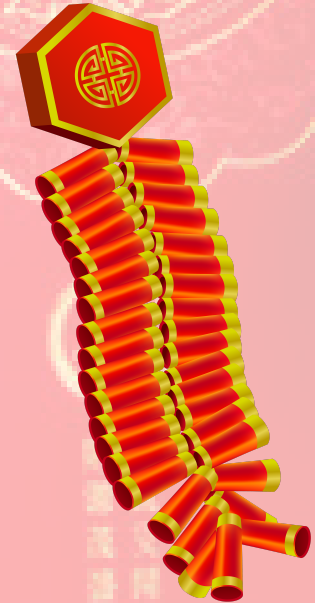

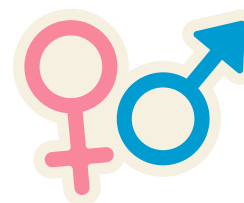

# THOUGHT PROCESSES ON SCHOOL & CLUB INCLUSION

The intention to include school-level awards in the Pairs and Teams events is to:

- Provide schools more avenues to compete against their peers in Bridge
- Provide students exposure to the open-level Bridge and different approaches to the play
- Set an achievable objective for schools participating in these events

For Pairs, to preserve the integrity of the level of play, schools can only send a maximum of two Pairs. Awards will also be limited to within these pairs.

Clubs also wish to find avenues to compete against their peers to win honors within the Club ecosystem. The Inter-club Pairs provides an avenue for players to strive for club representation and compete in an official event recognised by the NSA.

We understand that several clubs have more difficulty securing talent due to their club membership structure, hence affecting their competitiveness against clubs with an more open membership structure. While all players will compete in a single field, we have decided to separate the final results into the Public/Private category for awards purposes.

SCBA's will discuss with each club on such matters, and this assessment will be final.

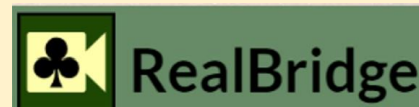

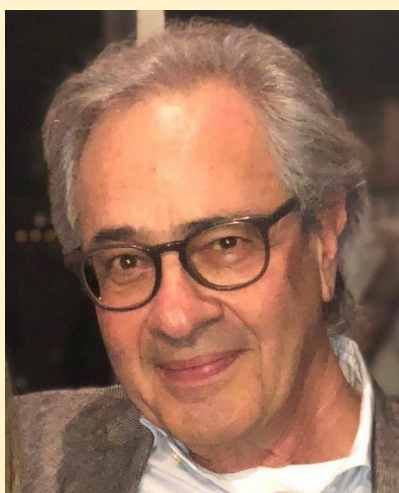
